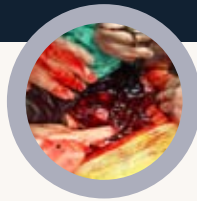
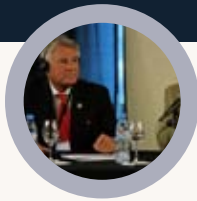
Learning Objectives

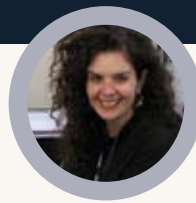
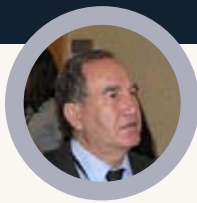
